The agricultural industry is a key economic driver in many northern communities.

Ontario is helping Thunder Bay area farmers improve their agricultural land, diversify crops and expand their businesses. Bill Mauro, MPP for Thunder Bay-Atikokan, was in Thunder Bay to announce funding through the Northern Ontario Heritage Fund Corporation (NOHFC) to install tile drainage on 1,390 acres of land and to undertake land clearing on 354 acres, a project led by the Thunder Bay Agricultural Research Association in partnership with 23 local farms.

Some of the districts we serve around the Thunder Bay agricultural areas, Rainy river, Nipigong, State river valley, White river, Neebing, Kaministiquia.
